DRAW TIMES

Among the factors we had to consider in scheduling the Games was the travel time to and from Marquette.

We believe these draw times will allow for adequate travel to and from.

DIVISIONS

This is a 24-team event and, based on the experience level, we will have a single bracket event or a two-bracket event with the second bracket being a less the 3 years' experience bracket. Each team is guaranteed a minimum of three games.

RULES

The USCA rules shall apply.

Tiebreaking method: After the first game in each division is played, each member of the team will throw one rock trying to get as close to the center of the button (the pin) as possible. The cumulative distance of the teams four throws measured in inches from the center of the button will be used in any tie breaking situations during the tournament.

NOTE:

- A) Any stone that misses the house will be counted as 100" (not the regular 72").
- B) Sweeping will be permitted for the tie breaker throws.
- C) If there is a situation where two teams have the same tie breaking number and the tie cannot be broken, we will have a coin toss to break the tie.
